 - a. Course Change Proposal: CURRIC 733 Public Engagement with Science

b. New Course Proposal: ART 307 Making Comics 1

This new major is a joint proposal from Kinesiology, RPSE, and Ed Psych, with the major housed in Kinesiology. It arose from a need on campus for a major that prepares students to work

in health related fields with a bachelor's degree. This major also focuses on health equity, making this major unique in the UW system. The major is 40 credits of work. This proposal has passed all three departments, now moving forward through campus governance. This major will serve students that are already on campus rather than recruiting students to campus. The committee noted Table 3 needed edits for clarity for credit loads and needed to clearly separate the headings. Approved.

e. Topics Courses Policy Feedback

The committee discussed the topics course guidelines that have been proposed from campus. They noted how many topics courses there are currently in use and faculty resistance to proposing a new proposal.
